Monday, July 11, 7:00 PM

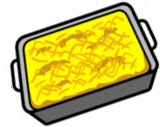

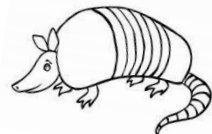


## Ice Cream Social

## Life Line Screening
