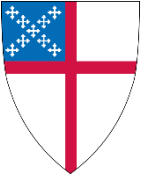
Trinity Canteen

Sunday, January 29

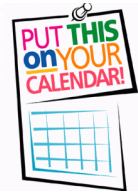

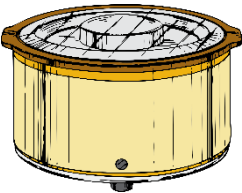


The Bishop is coming! Bishop DeDe Duncan-Probe will be here on Sunday, February 26, 2017 for her triannual visitation. More info to follow.

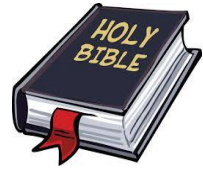
