Bishop Visitation

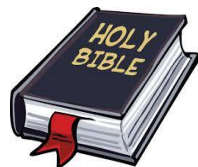
Sunday, February 26th

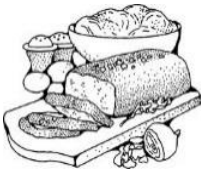
The Rector's Forum will be at 11:00 a.m. today.

Lenten Program

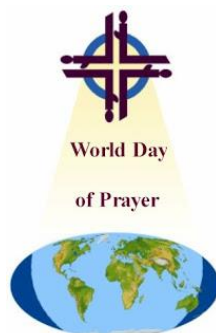
