Saturday, February 25th



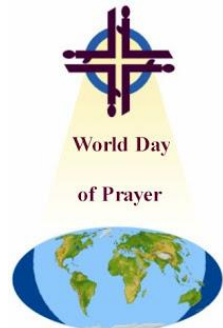

WOC Luncheon

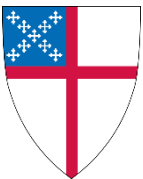
Wednesday, February 15
