## No Forum Today

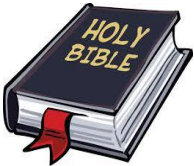

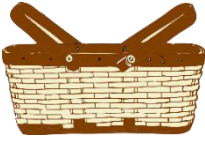
