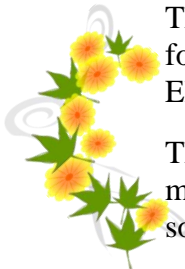

Today at 6PM

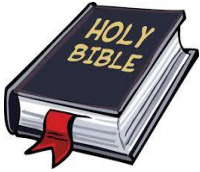

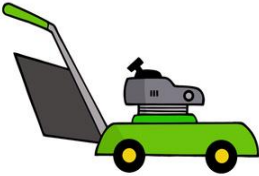
Cottage Visits
