November 19th at 12:15 PM

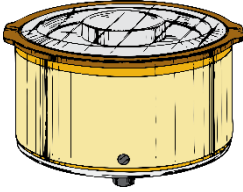

500th Anniversary of the Reformation

Sunday, November 19th at 4:00 PM

The area Lutheran Churches are offering a commemoration service of the 500th anniversary of the Reformation. It was in 1517 that Martin Luther, a Roman Catholic monk, publicly made known his concerns about the nature of the Church by nailing his protesting thoughts to the door of a church. He called for a Reformation.

Bishop John Macholz of the Upstate N.Y. Synod will deliver the sermon and preside over the Eucharist (open to all). A combined choir will present an anthem composed by local organist Jim Ford. A praise band will deliver supporting musical pieces.

Clergy of our sister and brother denominations are invited to “robe” and participate in the procession.

All are invited to attend this worship experience at Christ the King Church, 499 Plaza Drive, Vestal. A reception follows.
