## **CPR/AED/First Aid Training**

Saturday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, 9AM to 4PM



The Vestry has approved the purchase of an AED (defibrillator) for the Church. In order to purchase this equipment, we must have people trained in its use. We are offering a class on Saturday, March 17<sup>th</sup> from 9 AM to 4 PM, here at the church. This class will include CPR/AED training for adults and pediatrics as well as Emergency First Aid.
