Covid Update: Effective March 13, 2022

RED ZONE: Masks required, physical distancing, no sharing of food or drink, only vaccinated people in small groups.

YELLOW ZONE:

- Masks optional for vaccinated people.
- One side of church will be untaped. The other side will be for physical distancing and masks.
- Food and drink may be shared.
- Groups may meet in-person.
- Unvaccinated people who want to participate in a small group **MUST** wear a KN 94 or N 95 mask. The mask must be worn at all times.
