### Recycle your K-Cups

We are still collecting used K-cups for recycling. The box is in the cloak room and the church office. Feel free to save up a bunch then drop them off at church. Or, simply leave a bag outside the Christian Ed door. Once the bin is full, it is shipped by UPS to g2 Revolution, an innovative recycling company. 75% of the cups by weight is converted to compost. 25% of the cups by weight is converted into recycled products.
